- * We try to exhibit all of the student entries. If that is not possible, we ask the teachers to pick several best of class.
- * There is no entry fee for students.
- * There will be a hands-on area set aside for children and adults to explore fun techniques for making things from recycled materials.

- * **MEDIA** The acceptable media is any material which is the second use for that object or material. All works must contain a minimum of 75% of recycled materials. A good criterion is that the materials you use would have ended up the landfill if you hadn't rescued them for art.
- * **SUGGESTIONS:**
old toys, jewelry, machine parts, lumber scraps, paper mache from old newspapers, collages from old magazines or photos.

- * **CATEGORIES** The Student Competition has three divisions; Children= Pre-K to 2rd, Youth=3rd to 6th, Teen=7th to 12th. The categories will be judged separately by several prominent local artists.
